### **MARIAN MONSOON FEST**

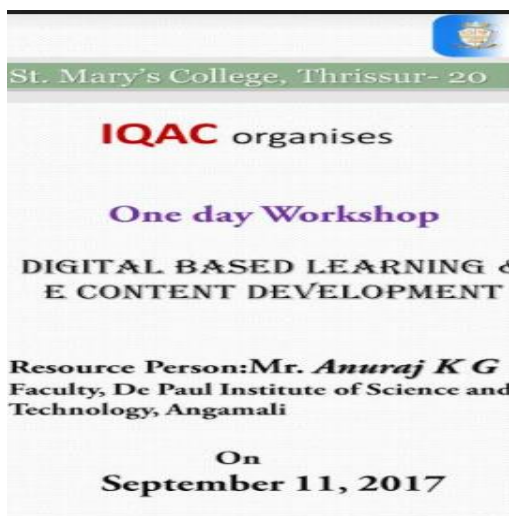

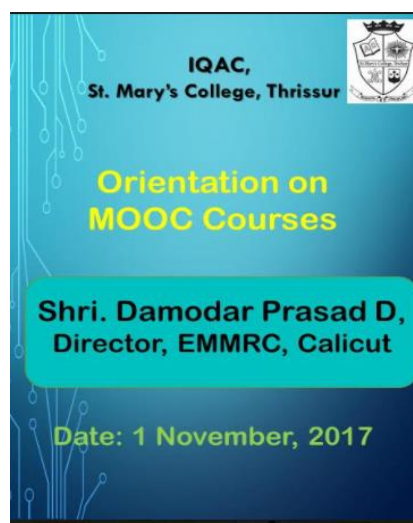
## **TOPPERS' DAY**

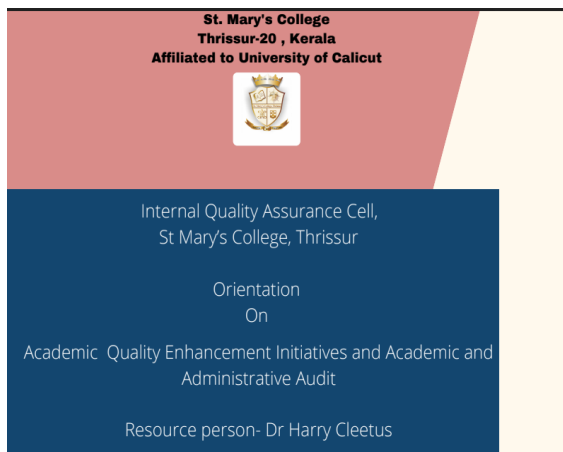

## **SPECTRUM 2018- POWER POINT PRESENTATION COMPETITION**

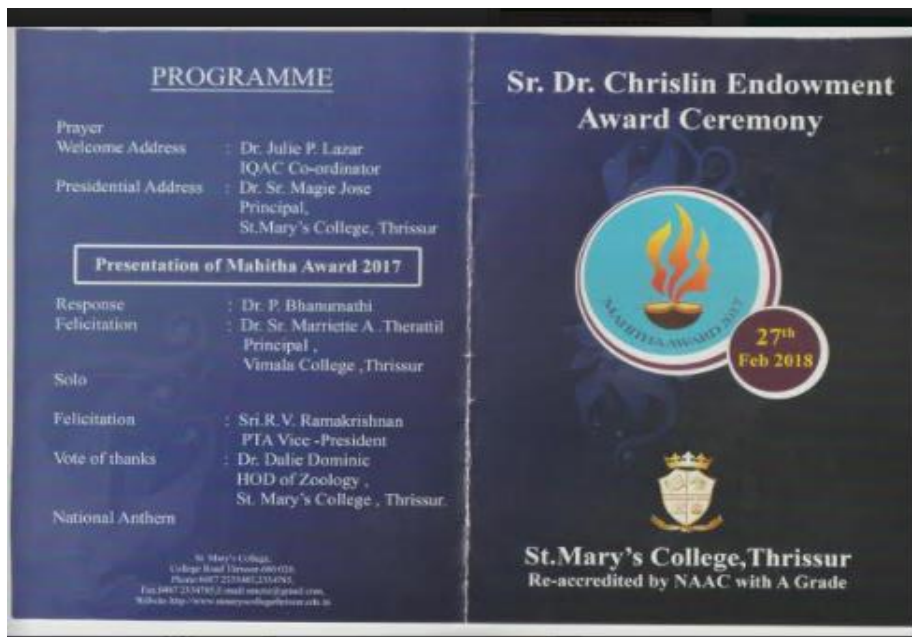

## **SR. DR. CHRISLIN ENDOWMENT AWARD CEREMONY – MAHITHA AWARD**

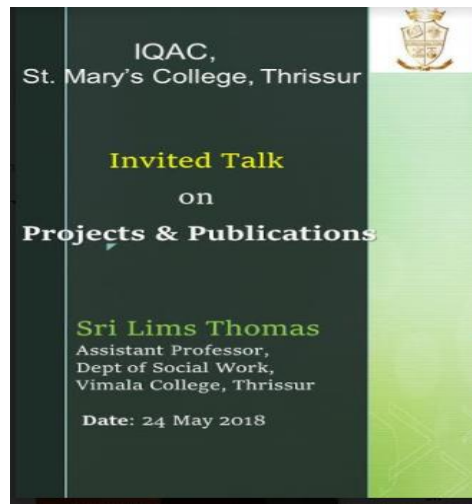
